October 11, 2017 is National Stop Bullying Day. Recently, there has been a lot of focus on bullying in school and on the internet (cyber bullying). But what really is bullying? According to **StopBullying.gov**, bullying is unwanted, aggressive behavior that involves a real or perceived imbalance of power. An imbalance of power is when kids who bully use their power—such as physical strength, access to embarrassing information, or popularity-to control or hurt others. At times, kids will argue with each other. Although annoying; this is not a form of bullying. Arguments tend to be more easily fixed by kids themselves but sometimes require an intervention from a friend or adult who can help kids find the middle ground. This year's crossover games will be played at the Heritage opponent's field. The District 5 AA semifinals are set for Saturday, November 4 at the home field of the higher seed. The district championship is set for Friday, November 10 at a neutral site.

The Lady Mountaineer Volleyball team leads the WestPAC South Section and currently holds the number 1 seed in District 5 A with an 8-1 record. The WestPAC championship game is set for Tuesday, October 24 at a site and time to be determined.
