## 4<sup>th</sup>

### 4<sup>th</sup> grade

4<sup>th</sup> graders are applying all of their math understanding to PSSA prep work in their Coach Books. Students are now able to use all four math operations in multi-step word problems and multi-digit computational problems, convert between different measurement units, and use their understanding of place value from 7-digit whole numbers to the hundredths place.

Spring has officially begun. With the arrival of spring, comes the start of spring sports. Please help your child continue practicing excellent work habits by reinforcing the importance of balancing the responsibilities of academic success alongside sports participation.

#### PSSA

Grades three through eight will be completing the Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSAs) on the following dates:

ELA PSSA April 9, 10, and 11 Math PSSA April 16, and 17 Science (grades 4, and 8) April 23, and 24

These assessments will take place during the morning of each testing date. Students do not have a time limit and will be permitted to use as much time as necessary to complete their daily assigned testing session successfully.

What is the PSSA? The Pennsylvania System of School Assessment provides an understanding of student performance related to the attainment of the academic standards. The information gathered after this assessment is used to provide insight into curriculum and ways to improve. It also shows teachers and administration how hard your children have worked throughout the school year! Berlin teachers design their curriculum to not only prepare their students for these tests, but to teach to the "whole child" and to make learning fun and exciting.

What can I do? You can help your child prepare for the PSSA by asking practice questions, reviewing Math concepts, and by continuing to read!

On the day of the test...make sure that your child gets a good night's rest and eats a well-balanced breakfast. This will give them a great start to their day!

<u>Try not to worry...</u>teachers encourage the students to "show what you know" and have been working hard to ensure that the students are as calm and relaxed about the

test as possible. The afternoons are filled with exciting activities to give the students a chance to wind down after a long morning.
