On the same day, they will also travel to the Extension Office in Somerset for FARM CITY DAY. On May 17th, they will take their learning to the big city of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania! Third graders will spend a very interesting and exciting day at the Carnegie Science Center! Their third and final field trip will be an annual walking field trip to The Ice Cream Station sometime in late May!

4th grade

Fourth graders will begin a hands-on approach to life cycles of organisms, organisms and their environments, and the characteristics of organisms while taking on the responsibilities and routines of raising chicks from the embryology stage. The eggs are in the incubators, and will hatch mid-May. Students will candle the embryos in their eggs, and watch as they hatch and begin to grow into chickens.

Design a fish in its habitat, cast a fishing pole, observe a man-made water fall, and pull up live specimens from a local creek bottom...these are all activities fourth graders will explore on their Laurel Hill State Park field trip May 23. Fourth graders will be walking to the Berlin Grove May 15, while eating their lunches and spending the afternoon there. Their last trip will be to walk to the Ice Cream Station on May 24th.


Maker Faire
