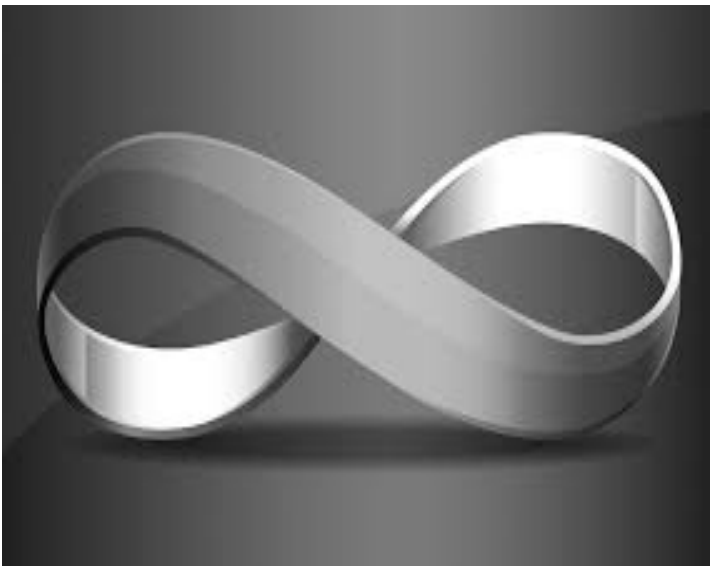


Berlin Summer Library 2018
