Scholarships in the amount of \$1000 each, unless otherwise specified, will be awarded to Berlin Brothersvalley High School seniors. **Scholarships will be awarded to students who plan to attend accredited post-secondary four-year colleges, post-secondary two-year programs, vocational or technical schools.** Applicants must have a GPA of 2.5 or better. *The award will be presented to your college or technical school on your behalf after successful completion of the first term at the post-secondary institution.*

School attendance will be a consideration in the awarding of all scholarships.

**A. Daniel Sterner Memorial Scholarship:**

Independent individuals with independent beliefs who have demonstrated empathy of others will be considered. Applicants should communicate plans and dreams for their future.

**B. McKenzie-Raupach Memorial Scholarship:**

The McKenzie family honored William and Althea McKenzie by establishing a memorial scholarship for BBHS students. The McKenzies were both extraordinary examples of people who were not willing to allow obstacles to stand in their way of success. Mr. McKenzie was a veteran of both the Korean War and WW II for which he volunteered his service. He was a poor reader who was not able to spell well. He was determined to go to college and, with the help of his wife as his reader, he was able to graduate with a degree in mechanical engineering. After working for John Deere, he started and ran his own successful company. Mrs. McKenzie worked in a factory all of her life. In her later years, she became legally blind. She was a very simple person who found happiness in others and not in possessions. The endowment to the scholarship is representative of what was important to the couple: education, helping others, and giving back to the rural community of their roots. Applicants with financial need will be strongly considered.

**C. Berlin Brothersvalley School District Foundation Scholarship:**

Recipients should be well rounded, ambitious and motivated individuals who have made the most of the opportunities offered by the Berlin schools and the local community.

**D. Matthew Deeter Technology Scholarship:**

Students who plan on advancing their study in the field of computer science/information technology may apply. This is a \$500 scholarship.

**E. Education Scholarship:**

Students who plan on becoming teachers may apply.

**F. William Harris Memorial Scholarship:**

Students who plan on advancing their study in the field of art may apply. Amount to be determined.
