Health and Safety Guidelines for Athletic Facilities Beginning October 9, 2020

- 1) Per gathering guidelines released on October 6, 2020, BBSD will be adhering to the following spectator attendance parameters:
 - a. 25% Capacity for Outdoor Venues
 - i. Varsity Football—550 spectators will be admitted into the stadium. 400 tickets will be allocated to the home team and 150 tickets will be allocated to the visiting team. Pre-sale tickets will be sold to participants only.
 - Home team spectators will be provided seating with adequate social distancing in the west (home) bleacher section of the stadium. Visiting team spectators will be provided seating with adequate social distancing in the east (visitor) bleacher section of the stadium.
 - ii. Sub-Varsity Football—550 tickets will be made available at the gate.
 - iii. JH and Varsity Soccer— Spectator attendance at all levels of soccer competitions will be limited to 250 individuals.
 - 1. Facial coverings and social distancing will be required of all spectators, coaches, and other game day personnel.
 - b. 20% Capacity for Indoor Venues
 - i. Varsity Volleyball—120 spectators will be admitted into the HS Gymnasium. Two tickets per participant will be allocated.
 - 1. Facial coverings and social distancing will be required of all spectators, coaches, and other game day personnel.
 - ii. JH Volleyball—100 spectators will be permitted into the MS Gymnasium with no admission charged.
- 2) Athletes should avoid congregating in groups before or after practice.
- 3) Athletes will be encouraged to wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer before and after workouts.

- 4) Athletes will be encouraged to avoid touching their eyes, nose and mouth.
- 5) Weight room and sports equipment will be sanitized before and after workouts.
- **6)** Teams will not share water bottles or hydration devices. Individual water containers will be provided.
- 7) Locker room procedures will be adjusted to maintain social distancing. Locker room facilities will be made available for visiting teams, but they are encouraged to come dressed and only use locker rooms for restroom facilities.
- **8)** Face coverings are required per District per the BBSD Health and Safety Plan.
- **9)** Athletes should stay home when feeling ill. Coaches should monitor athletes and if an athlete shows any signs of being ill they should be sent home.
- 10) The attendance of visiting band and cheerleaders for fall athletic events will be at the discretion of the host school.
