Health and Safety Guidelines for Athletic Facilities **Beginning December 4, 2020**

- 1) Per gathering guidelines released on November 23, 2020, BBSD will be adhering to the following spectator attendance parameters:
 - a. 10% of Maximum Occupancy for Indoor Venues
 - i. High School Gym (Basketball and Wrestling)—Two tickets per participant will be allocated.
 - ii. Middle School Gym (Basketball and Wrestling)— Two tickets per participant will be allocated.
- 2) The updated Pennsylvania masking order will be enforced with all individuals present in the gymnasiums being required to wear a face covering with the exception of only athletes who are engaged in athletic competition.
- 3) For the sport of Rifle, all coaches and team members must wear a face covering at all times except when the safety of the individual could be compromised by the face covering.
- 4) Only team personnel will be permitted to enter the rifle range. No spectators will be permitted in the rifle range during practice or competitions.
- 5) On days when school is not in session, coaches will perform temperature checks on their athletes upon arriving to the facility or before boarding transportation to an away event.
- 6) Athletes should avoid congregating in groups before or after practice.
- 7) Athletes will be encouraged to wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer before and after practices and competitions.
- 8) Athletes will be encouraged to avoid touching their eyes, nose and mouth.
- 9) Teams will not share water bottles or hydration devices. Individual water containers will be provided.
- 10) Athletes should stay home when feeling ill. Coaches should monitor athletes and if an athlete shows any signs of being ill they should be sent home immediately.
