Health and Safety Guidelines for Athletic Facilities

Updated on September 10, 2020

- 1) Two tickets per rostered participant will be allocated for both the home and away teams for all levels of volleyball and football.
 - a. For competitions at all levels of volleyball, home team spectators will be provided seating with adequate social distancing in the south end bleachers of the high school gymnasium. Visiting team spectators will be provided seating with adequate social distancing in the north end bleachers of the high school gymnasium. Rostered athletes not participating in live competition will be seated above their team with face coverings and adequate social distancing.
 - i. Facial coverings will be required of all spectators, coaches, and other game day personnel.
 - b. For competitions of all levels of football, home team spectators will be provided seating with adequate social distancing in the west (home) bleacher section of the stadium. Visiting team spectators will be provided seating with adequate social distancing in the east (visitor) bleacher section of the stadium.
 - i. Facial coverings will be required of all spectators, coaches, and other game day personnel.
- 2) Spectator attendance at all levels of soccer competitions will be limited to 250 individuals.
 - a. Facial coverings will be required of all spectators, coaches, and other game day personnel.
- 3) Athletes should avoid congregating in groups before or after practice.
- 4) Athletes will be encouraged to wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer before and after workouts.
- 5) Athletes will be encouraged to avoid touching their eyes, nose and mouth.
- 6) Weight room and sports equipment will be sanitized before and after workouts.

- 7) Teams will not share water bottles or hydration devices. Individual water containers will be provided.
 - 8) Locker room procedures will be adjusted to maintain social distancing. Locker room facilities will be made available for visiting teams, but they are encouraged to come dressed and only use locker rooms for restroom facilities.
 - 9) Face coverings are required per District per the BBSD Health and Safety Plan.
 - 10) Athletes should stay home when feeling ill. Coaches should monitor athletes and if an athlete shows any signs of being ill they should be sent home.
 - 11) Per WestPAC Conference mandate, visiting band and cheerleaders will not be permitted to attend fall athletic events.
 - 12) In the event that PA HB 2787 becomes law, spectator attendance will not exceed 50% of the capacity of the athletic facility.
