

**What limits would you put on cell phone/technology usage for Students 5-8?**

No students 5-8 should have cell phone access during the school day.

Cell phones available in lockers only
Cell phone may be used during lunch/free periods only. If brought to class, must place upside down on desk.
put away during class/allow use during lunch
Only during free time
Cell phones not allowed out of bookbags/lockers during the school day
Cell phones are expensive and not all lockers stay shut reliably. Students can take them to class where they can then be put in a teacher-directed location (hanging wall organizer, etc. provided by district for each classroom for the sake of consistency and ease of enforcement. A building-level directive that is backed up by admin at all levels). Phones may be used between classes and during lunch. Phones do not go to restrooms because there are issues and I'm weary of excessive bathroom breaks where students are taking selfies, texting, and catching up with social media instead of being in class). Chromebooks only used at teacher direction. Otherwise in lockers on in a designated location in classroom. They play on them constantly.
Cell phones for grades 5-8 should be in backpacks/lockers or in a cell phone drop off in each room. There is no reason for students at this age to be on their cell phones during class time. Students may have cell phones out during lunch time or before/after school. Technology can be used as teachers see fit. If Chromebooks are not needed for a lesson, they stay closed and on the floor under desks.
No cellphone in classroom
They can have them in their lockers and at lunch, but they have no place in the classroom. Chromebooks should be put away unless they're being used in class for a specific topic.

Students phones need to be kept in their backpack and turned off during school hours. Phones are the biggest distraction in the classroom.
