- 1) **Title I Program-** we operate a **school wide program** in that all of our learners are eligible to receive academic assistance from our classrooms aides and reading intervention teacher.
- 2) **Title I Funds** - Are used to staff a Reading Intervention teacher and seven instructional aides to work in the classrooms along side our elementary teachers.
- 3) **Title I School Parent Involvement Policy-** Is listed on our district website under the school board tab. This can be found at www.bbsd.com
- 4) **Title I School/Parent Compact-** Is found in your child's student manual that will be sent home to families. Please read and review this with your child.
- 5) **Curriculum-** Students will learn English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Art, Music, Computers (grades 3 and 4), Physical Education as well as frequent visits to the Library to borrow books to read both in school and at home.
- 6) **Contacting Staff-** This may be done via e-mail or phone the school at 267- 4623 or a note written in the student planners. Our district website provides easy access to all staff e-mails and features staff websites and teacher lesson plans.
- 7) **Assessments-** PSSA is administered to grades 3 and 4. All students from Kindergarten to grade 4 are also assessed locally through the Dibels and Exact Path assessments. You will receive PSSA results of assessments included with student report cards. (note: Due to Covid-19 closures the PSSA was postponed in April 2020)

Throughout the year, you will receive information on these opportunities and requests for your participation. We also have an annual survey sent home for families to complete to assist us in best serving our learners needs.
